

unten falten




Die oberen

falten




Beide unteren

oben klappen




Dann eine Ecke nach

Ecke nach hinten falten




Das entstandene Dreieck

Ecken aufeinander legen




Nun die unteren

falten




Anschließend die


How does the mouse get the cheese?




Fold paper boat




First fold a piece of paper down




Fold the top corners towards the middle




Fold both bottom edges upwards




Then fold one corner forward and the other corner back




Open the resulting triangle and place the two corners on top of each other




Now fold the bottom corners up



Then press the corners together



Pull apart as shown



And the boat is ready!
